To the Court:

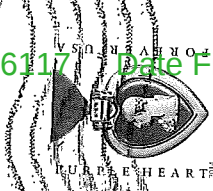

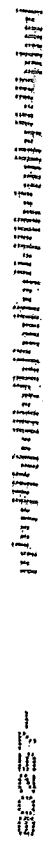
