Dear Ms. Sargent-Burns:

This letter is the latest of many that have been sent to you in the above matter. ***However***, something new has happened that *must*, incite you to act in this matter. President Donald Trump has raised a cry of “injustice” upon finding the jury foreman in the “trial” of Roger Stone—Tomeka Hart—is a “Trump-hating, Russian collusion hoaxer” by her own admission. Her social media posts reveal an obvious bias against Defendant Stone and her failure to recuse herself from serving on his jury is therefore a criminal act!
